Families First Panel featuring Amala Sista, DDS Program Coordinator

On March 20th, Amala Sista was invited to be a panelist at Supporting Families with Disabilities: Community Efforts in Benton County. The event was coordinated by United Way Benton County Director, Mr. Carlos Garbutt. She spoke about how families can turn barriers into opportunities. Here's some of what she shared in an article written by Kayley Ramsey that was published in Smart Justice, A Service of Restore Hope.

She spoke of her personal experience caring for a loved one with dementia.

"One of the biggest challenges is a lack of information," she explained. "Families often don't even know how these services exist." She encouraged families to apply early, despite long wait lists, stressing that "the wait should not be a deterrent."
